Housed in a salt warehouse, the museum immerses you in the heart of **the salt marsh heritage**.

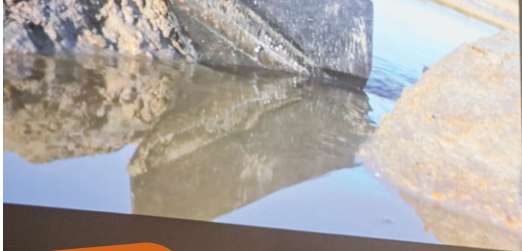
It invites you on a journey where **the traditions of the past meet modern craftsmanship**
